Extreme Reading

Ask an adult to take a picture of you reading somewhere unusual, for example on Dartmoor or on the beach!



Book Review

Choose a book you have read. It could be your favourite book or a book you have really enjoyed. Write your review, give it a rating and draw or print a picture of the book cover.

Top Ten

Create a top ten of your favourite books with a member of your family. It could be your brother or sister, mum or dad. You could even write a sentence to explain why you both really like the books.

Read a Classic

Ask an adult at home about their favourite books when they were a child.
Together with your adult, read one of these books. Can you review it with your adult?

Dress up

Dress up as your favourite book character and ask your adult to take a picture. Write a few sentences to explain why you really like this character.

Make your own book cover

Read a book of your choice. It could be fiction or non fiction. Design and make your own front cover for the book.

Make a Reading Den

Work together with someone in your family to make your own reading den and ask an adult to take a photo of you reading in your den.

Make your own Comic

Use the story from a book that you enjoy to make into your own comic strip.
Remember to write the key parts of the story, or use speech bubbles.
