PARKING ON THE DOUBLE YELLOW LINES

After the serious traffic accident last week, the Police requested us to remind parents about NOT parking in School Lane on the double yellow lines. The double yellow lines were put there, amongst other reasons, to allow through drivers to pass the school safely and to allow all drivers to have a clear view of any parents and children crossing the road.

We put out an extra Poppleford Post publicising the Police request.

The police themselves attended on a number of days outside the school checking that no-one parked on the double yellow lines.

A number of parents discussed active ways of approaching the problem.

Unbelievably, we have had reports of cars STILL parking on the double yellow lines.

The Cannon Inn have very kindly agreed to let any cars taking children to school to park there both before school at 9.00am and after school at 3.15pm.

The Pavilion Car Park in Back Lane is also available for those who wish to combine a short walk with taking their children into school.

There are a number of roads away from any through routes where careful and considerate parking for a short time would be understood by local residents.

If you live in the village, please, seriously consider walking with your children to school. Perhaps, even group together with other local parents. The fewer cars that park around the school, the smaller the chance of repeating the serious traffic accident from last week.
