Newton Poppleford School Association: End of Year Financial Report

Treasurer's Report to the AGM

The summary of the Newton Poppleford School Association accounts for the year ending 31st August 2015 are attached. These have been independently audited by Joan Smith on behalf of the PTFA, I would like to extend my thanks to Joan for giving up the time to audit the accounts.

The PTFA raised a total of £5,339.58 in the last school year, which is a fantastic result and an increase of 83% on last years' fundraising. In addition to this funds from Rainbow Pre-School and Toddler Group will be transferred, which amounts to £8,574.68, this will be held in the PTFA deposit account until the new build is completed rather than being dispersed to other unrelated charities or schools and will be reflected in the 2015/2016 accounts.

The most successful events were:

- A. Summer Fête raising £1,604.06 (£2,057.74 before expenses)
- B. Xmas Fayre raising £729.87 (£1,002.11 before expenses)
- C. Cake Sales raised an amazing £928.90 (£935.55 before expenses)

We would like to thank everyone involved for their time and support in raising this amount – without your efforts, we could not hope to raise so much for the school.

We also received a number of donations though-out the year which amounted to £354.00 and we extend a big thank you to all those who have donated so generously.

The introduction of TheGivingMachine, which provides fundraising through On-Line shopping has resulted in an additional income of £34.47 which we hope will increase next year through further awareness of the scheme.

Through this fundraising, the PTFA have donated a total of £4,062.42 to the school which has been used to support the purchase of books, sports equipment and various workshops.

These donations include:

- A. Library books and books to support the curriculum (£1,995.32)
 (£1,004.81 was carried over from 2013/14 as it was not spent before the end of the financial year)
- B. A Sports Kit to be used for all our sporting events to help everyone feel part of a team (£295.03)
- C. Events such as The Jacolly Puppet Theatre, Kev the Comic and Maths Workshop (£1006.14)

The current account now holds £4,669.40 with £28.53 in the deposit account.

The PTFA supported a wide range of school activities from a workshop by Kev the comic strip artist to music

workshops and maths events – see examples on the right. In total over £4000 was donated to the school.

Over £4300 of funds were raised in the 2014-15 academic year – £990 was also donated by Little Popples Pre-School fundraising committee for books. Fundraising highlights included:

We received financial donations of £250 over the course of the year from two local businesses (Exeter Window Store and AlFindlay.com), for which we are very grateful. We greatly appreciate the wonderful raffle prizes donated by local businesses and attractions throughout the South West.
