We have now received some guidance from the ECB, which means that in line with the government roadmap plan we will be able to run outdoor sessions after 12 April.

We have therefore decided to run the FREE 4-week introduction to cricket sessions for girls, that we promised last year. These will take place ahead of our Girls Dynamos which starts on 14 May.

The challenges of home schooling as a temporary teacher and supporting your child as a parent has been difficult.


As we look towards the Easter break, prioritising ways you and your family can look after your mental health and taking time out to be only a parent again is so important.
