Preloved school uniform pop-up shop

Clothing Bank

A 'Bags of Help' clothing bank has now been installed by the bike park. This is paid in weight and is collected every fortnight.

Parish Council Firework Night Event

The Parish council have approached the PTFA first refusal on the concession for all hot food. The PC is proposing a £150 concession fee (funds to go to the NPPFF pavilion charity). In addition, the PTFA will assist with ticket sales and supply stewards on the night. Each steward will receive 2 free tickets.

In generally the group felt that this would be a good option whilst also building a relationship with the PC.

Steve at the Canon has agreed to do the BBQ with his equipment free of charge.

Christmas Cards

This was a great fundraiser last year and raised £623. Jody Hall has offered to coordinate the artwork and orders in school again.

Outdoor Project Update

Sadly, the company that we spent almost £1000 with for pergola and benches has gone into liquidation. The PTFA are currently trying to claim the money back.

We are also sourcing replacement items from other suppliers but this means the project will be delayed.
