The PTFA have funded and created a school allotment. You've probably noticed it slowly growing in stages and saw the first 'lockdown crop' harvested! We were very pleased to be involved in providing this important resource for our children. They can use it to learn about growing their own food and will get to experience the pleasure of watching their food grow, from seed to fork. We are delighted to declare it now fully open for growing business!

Our school allotment features nine raised beds, one for each class and an extra for a gardening club! We have a fruit orchard, poly tunnel, water butt, storage boxes, and various tools including 30x trowels, forks, kids gardening gloves, kneeling mats, and watering cans.

We have planted a fruit orchard next to the allotment, with apple, pear, plum, and sweet cherry trees. This orchard was kindly funded by Mr Filer as a gift to the children and we are very grateful for this kind and generous gesture.
