

Wondrous Wednesdays!

As mentioned in one of our newsletters before the summer break, following a review of the school's curriculum, we are introducing various changes this year. The children will finish Wednesdays with 'Golden Time', except those children who during the week have had a red or yellow card. They will miss some or all of their 'Golden Time'. We are making the best use of staff expertise in enhancing the children's learning in these areas. In terms of the PE lessons, children in Years 1 and 2 will only change their footwear for this lesson. We would request that children in Years 3, 4 and 5 come into school that morning in their PE kit. They will change back into their school uniform before lunch. Year 6 will need to bring their PE kit in and change into it before lunch ready for the afternoon.
