## **RECEPTION APPLICATIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 2021–**

### **DEADLINE 15TH JANUARY 2020**

If you have a child that is due to start school in September 2021 then the deadline for applications is Friday 15th January. The best way to apply is via the Citizen portal: [www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline](http://www.devon.gov.uk/admissionsonline) or if you would prefer to make an application via a paper form then please request this from the school office.

If you need help in making an application then please do not hesitate to contact the school office - we are more than willing to help you complete an application online or will scan paper forms through to DCC Admissions if you would like us to.

Your child may be disadvantaged if you do not make an application by the deadline, as their application will be considered late. If the school you are applying to is likely to be oversubscribed then late applications are very likely to be refused admission, regardless of their priority for a place at the school.
