As I am sure you are all aware, it is the Queen's Platinum Jubilee next year. The government have announced that there is to be an extra Bank holiday for this on Thursday 2nd June, with the Spring Bank Holiday moving from Monday 30th May to Friday 3rd June.

For the vast majority of schools this extra bank holiday falls in half-term, as it does for us. The government have now passed legislation for next year reducing the number of days children have to be in school from 190 days to 189 days. The governors therefore have decided to add the extra day's holiday onto that week, therefore **Monday 6th June 2022** will be an additional day's holiday.
