Dear All,

As we head towards late autumn and crisper morning's the children have been engaging in some excellent learning in the school. I have been wowed by some of the historical writing (particularly about the Stone Age) and how knowledgeable the children are. The curriculum continues to be enriched with visitors and trips across the age groups and more is planned for this term. We received a letter from the great Niece of Sergeant Bernard Verriour. Bernard was a pupil and used to live in the school as he was the son of the ex headteacher. The pupil leaders placed a poppy on her behalf at the memorial and we will be responding to her letter. It provided a personal link to all of us at the school of the importance of gratitude at this time. This week the school has participated in Anti-Bullying week and the children have been learning what we can do to ensure our school is happy, safe and a caring environment. They have engaged well and showed empathy,

understanding and care for each other. We are proud of their views and engagement with this subject. I know that in the past school closed early at the end of term, the school will no longer be doing this and the last day of term will be a full school day as normal.

Primary School Applications

You will be aware that children born between o1/09/2018 and 31/08/2019 are entitled to start full time Primary Education in September 2023. The application facility opens on 15th November 2022 and closes at midnight on 15th January 2023. It is important that parents apply before the closing date, even if they are intending to defer their child's application until later in the academic year, they must secure a place before that decision needs to be made. 
